

Wichita Asian Association Student Scholarship

The Wichita Asian Association (WAA) Student Scholarship is geared towards high school students in their junior year in Wichita and the surrounding areas. This year's criteria steers away from the traditional "model minority", but rather views the candidate as a whole - for their role in reforming Asian American ideals in modern society. This scholarship will occur in three segments; a personal statement, an individual interview, and a project presentation. At the end of each part, materials will be reviewed by a committee and judges to determine which individuals are selected to move on. The three final selected individuals will be awarded and recognized at Wichita Asian Festival in the fall of their senior year. Scholarship Amount: 1st place: \$5000, 2nd place: \$3000, 3rd place: \$2000.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a current Junior in High School (2022-2023 academic year Homeschool students are Also Eligible)
- Have an average academic GPA of 3.00 or higher.
- Be at least 1/4 Asian.
- Reside in Wichita or within a 50-mile radius of Wichita.
- Complete and submit the application along with all required supporting documents by the application deadline.
- Submit a recent photo.
- Be AVAILABLE to attend the dates stated in the timeline.

Timeline:

- April 3rd: Application opens.
- June 5th: Submissions are due at 11:59 PM.
- **June 11th 17th:** Applicants are notified by phone call and email if they have made it to the next step for an interview.
- June 25th 30th: Personal interviews with a panel of judges.
 - Interviewed applicants will be notified if they have made it to the final round of project presentations the night of their interview.
- **July 9th 14th:** Final presentation with a panel of judges.
- **September:** Winners will be notified.
- October 28th: Winners will be recognized at the 42nd Annual Wichita Asian Festival.
- **December:** Winners will be recognized at the Wichita Asian Association Honors Night.
